

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

The soft copy of the abstract of original quality research work on theme areas limited to 300 words (MS Word 2007, A4 size paper, 1.5 spaced, 12 font size, Times New Roman) with title, names of authors (Surname/ Last name followed by initials) and address of institute with e-mail ID of presenting author should be mailed to the Organizing Secretary, **on or before 15th Nov, 2019**. Abstract must be sent to issarnkl2019@gmail.com. The name of the presenting author should be in bold letter. The authors should indicate the session and mode of presentation (oral/poster) of their preference. However, the final decision will be taken by the organizing committee. Acceptance of paper(s) will be communicated to the presenting author through e-mail only after registration. Oral presentation will be restricted to 7 min, and poster should be of standard size, 4'L x 3'W. Quality papers will only be accepted for oral presentation. For each abstract, maximum no. of authors will be 5 only. The presenting author should be a first author for receiving award. Abstracts will be accepted only after paying the registration fee.

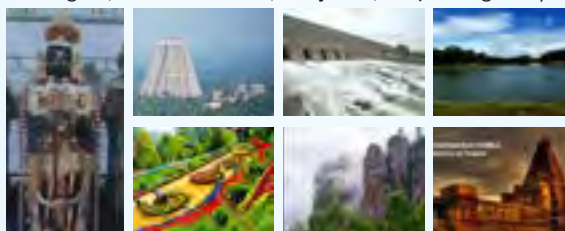

Dear friends and colleagues,

It gives us a great pleasure to announce the XXXV Annual Convention of The Indian Society for Study of Animal Reproduction (ISSAR) and International Symposium on “Global perspectives to enhance livestock fertility through modern reproductive techniques for doubling farmer’s income” to be conducted from December 18 to 20, 2019 by the Department of Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics at Veterinary College and Research Institute (VCRI), Namakkal, Tamil Nadu, India – 637 002.

Income is the most pertinent way to assess farmers’ economic well being and sectorial transformation. The crises and distresses plaguing the sector, endanger the very livelihoods and welfare of the farmers. Indian Government with the intention of giving enough policy thrust on income security, proposed to double the farmers’ income by 2022, platinum jubilee year of the Indian independence. Improving productivity in a huge population of low-producing animals by crossbreeding, upgrading and selective breeding are the most effective ways. Crossbreeding of non – descript with exotic stocks to enhance genetic potential of different species has been successful only to a limited extent. Conservation and propagation of indigenous bovines is of paramount importance to fulfil the public need of A₂ milk consumption.

The present International Symposium on “Global Perspectives to Enhance Livestock Fertility through Modern Reproductive Techniques for Doubling Farmer’s Income” will address the academicians, professionals, researchers and policy planners on the approaches to improve the productivity by enhancing the fertility of farm animals through modern reproductive techniques. Thus, we invite you to this event of knowledge sharing at VCRI, Namakkal, Tamil Nadu, India.

VENUE

NAMAKKAL, TAMIL NADU, INDIA

Namakkal is situated between 11°00’ to 12°00’ North latitudes and 77° 40’ to 78° 05 East longitudes. Namakkal town, popularly called as “Egg City” is the district headquarters and is a large commercial center for transport and motor vehicle body building. Among animal husbandry activities the chicken layer industry is well established with a massive population of more than 50 million birds available in this zone. Further, Namakkal is a milk shed area and rich in small ruminant population. Rasipuram ghee is famous for its purity. In Namakkal, there are two rock cut cave temples located on both side of a hillock dedicated to Lord Shri Lakshmi Narasimha and Shri Ranganatha. The Hanuman temple houses the largest Hanuman statue (18 feet) which is carved out of a single stone. The district has a number of tourist sights such as Kolli hills waterfalls, Tiruchengode Aarthanareeswarar hill temple, Namakkal fort Kailasanathar temple. Besides these Trichy city (85 Km), Yercaud hills station (90 Km), Tanjore (140 Km), Madurai (185 Km), Ooty hill station (225 Km), Kodaikanal hill station (260 Km), Kanyakumari (315 Km) and Rameswaram (320 Km) are the nearest pilgrimage and tourist places of interest in Tamil Nadu.

VCRI, NAMAKKAL

Veterinary College and Research Institute, Namakkal was started on 14.06.1985. It has been accredited by ICAR in 2001. It is a campus of 500 acres. The year 2009-2010 was celebrated as Silver Jubilee year of the college by conducting 25th ISSAR Annual Convention and International Symposium. It has been awarded as “THE BEST COLLEGE OF TANUVAS” during the year 2016

TRAVEL INFORMATION AND ACCOMMODATION

Namakkal town has a railway junction which is very well connected upto Salem, Karur and Erode railway junction and Chennai Central from all over the country. Frequent buses are available from Salem (57 Km), Karur (48 Km), Erode (60 Km) and Chennai (340 Km) to Namakkal Town.

Participants who wish to travel by flight can reach Trichy (85 Km), Coimbatore (160 km), Bangalore (250 Km) and Chennai (340 Km) airports and can reach the venue by road. The delegates will be accommodated in the guest houses in our campus as per University rates. Accommodation will be made on registration and first come first serve basis. Besides, good hotels, with tariff ranging from Rs.1000 to 3500 per day are available in and around the campus, which can also be booked with advance intimation.
