1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1.1. Application

The application form and list of various disciplines of M.V.Sc. programme available for admission of students of foreign national may be downloaded from the website www.tanuvac.ac.in.

1.2. Eligibility

- ❖ **Applicants must be citizens of any foreign country possessing foreign passports and not of Indian origin.**
- ❖ **Foreign students who wish to apply for the course in Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University should send their applications along with NOC from Indian embassy of the concerned country.**

1.2.1. Academic Qualifications

- ❖ Candidates qualified with B.V.Sc. & A.H. (Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry) or its equivalent degree from a recognized University shall be eligible to apply for M.V.Sc. degree course.
- ❖ Admission shall be offered only to the candidates who possess the qualification prescribed.

1.3. Application Registration Fee

A Bank Draft for **US\$ 100** drawn in favour of the **Finance Officer, TANUVAS, Chennai**, payable at **Chennai, India** drawn from the Nationalized Banks of India or other International Banks with branches in India should be submitted along with the application.

1.4. Last date for Receipt of Application

Application complete in all respects should reach the **Chairman, Admission Committee (PG), Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Madhavaram Milk Colony, Chennai 600 051, India** on or before **19.08.2016**.

1.5 Selection of candidates

The Admission Committee will scrutinize the Programme of the courses studied by the candidate along with the performance records for selection.

1.5.1. Admission will be provided subject to production of the following documents:

1. Proof for the Citizenship of the candidate
2. Passport of the candidate
3. Qualifying mark list of the candidate: if the grades are produced, certificates showing equivalent marks to grades should be submitted
4. Valid Visa
5. No Objection Certificate from Indian Embassy of the country concerned
6. Provisional Degree Certificate
7. Transfer Certificate

1.5.2. Final allotment of the branch of study and order of admission will be issued after verification of the certificates.

1.6. Payment of Fee

a) Institutional Economic Fee and Development Fee

On receipt of selection order, candidates of Foreign National category have to pay the Institutional Economic Fee and Development Fee as prescribed by the University, **by demand draft in US Dollars** drawn in favour of **“The Finance Officer, TANUVAS, Chennai”** payable at Chennai, India.

i) Development fee

An one time Development fee of **US \$ 2000** shall be paid at the time of admission

ii) Institutional Economic Fee

Note: For each extended year of study, an additional fee of **US \$ 3,000 per annum** needs to be paid.

b) Other fees

Other regular fees such as Tuition fee, Special fee, Examination fee, Boarding and Lodging fees, etc. **should be paid either in Indian Rupees or its equivalent in US Dollars** at the time of admission or when required to be paid, as per the rules of the University.

FEEES INCLUDING INSTITUTIONAL ECONOMIC FEE AND DEVELOPMENT FEE ONCE PAID ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.

1.7. Fitness:

Candidates have to submit a medical fitness certificate at the time of final allotment as per Annexure-II in application.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

2.1. Reporting to the University:

Normally, the academic session begins by **September - October** every year. Candidates selected for admission and remitted the fees with necessary original certificates are required to report to the Dean of the College concerned on the scheduled date mentioned in the campus allotment order. If the candidate fails to do so, the offer of admission will automatically stand cancelled.

2.2. All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They shall be liable to cancellation at any stage during the study if it is found that an admission was contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicants or their parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.

2.3. It shall be the discretion of the University to allot M.V.Sc. candidates to any of the two colleges.

2.4. Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University reserves the right to cancel or vary any of these rules without notice.

2.5. Hostel Accommodation:

Hostel accommodation is available inside the campus. Interested Candidates may apply to the Dean of the campus for Hostel admission. They have to pay the prescribed fee as per Hostel Rules. There is no separate Hostel for Foreign National students. The Hostel Mess is run on dividing system.

3. PREVENTION OF RAGGING

University is taking stringent measures to prevent ragging in the University campuses and Hostels. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the University authority, the concerned student(s) shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory the authority would expel such student(s) from the institution.
