**1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

**1.1. Application Form**

The application form can be downloaded from the website: [www.tanuv.ac.in](http://www.tanuv.ac.in), filled in and submitted along with necessary enclosures **on or before 03.07.2017, 05:45 PM.**

**1.2. Eligibility and Academic Qualifications**

**Applicant must be foreign national possessing foreign passport and must not be of Indian origin.**

**i) Eligibility for admission to BVSc & AH**

Candidates must have completed 12 years (10+2) of school education of Indian system or its equivalent for BVSc & AH programme.

Candidates who have studied in **English medium** and obtained a pass in the qualifying examination with Good Grades in Biology (or Botany and Zoology), Physics and Chemistry are eligible for admission to the above programmes.

Candidates studied in other medium of instruction may produce the proficiency certificate for their skill in reading, writing and speaking English from recognized Institutes.

**ii) Eligibility for admission to BTech (Food Technology)**

Candidates must have completed 12 years (10+2) of school education of Indian system or its equivalent for BTech (Food Technology) programme.

Candidates who have studied in English medium and obtained a pass in the qualifying examination with Good Grades in Biology, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry are eligible for admission to the above programmes.

Candidates studied in other medium of instruction may produce the proficiency certificate for their skill in reading, writing and speaking English from recognized Institutes.

**1.2. Age limit:**

*Minimum*

- Candidates should have attained the age of **17 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017.**

*Maximum*

- Candidates should not have completed **25 years as on 01.07.2017.**

**No relaxation of minimum and maximum age limit is permissible on any grounds**

**1.4. Registration Fee**

**A Bank Draft for US \$ 100 drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, TANUVAS, Chennai, payable at Chennai, India** drawn from the Overseas Branch of Nationalized Banks of India or other International Banks with branches in India should be submitted along with the application.

**1.5. Receipt of filled application**

Application complete in all respects should reach **The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Madhavaram Milk Colony, Chennai - 600 051, Tamil Nadu, India** on or before **03.07.2017, 05:45 PM through the embassy of the respective country / government.**

**1.6. Selection of candidates**

Selection will be done based on Academic Merit. Eligibility will be decided on scrutinization of subjects studied and marks obtained in the concerned subjects.

**1.7. Original Documents to be submitted at the time of admission**

1. Proof for the Citizenship of the candidate
2. Photocopy of the passport of the candidate (original Passport to be shown for verification)
3. Qualifying mark list of the candidate: if the grades are produced, Certificates showing equivalent marks to grades should be submitted.
4. Certificate showing that the candidate has undergone the qualifying school education in **English medium** (or) Certificate showing the skill of reading, writing and speaking English from recognized Institutes.
5. Copy of Valid VISA.
6. Eligibility Certificate / No Objection Certificate from Indian Embassy.

**1.8. Final order of admission will be issued after verification of the certificates/documents.**

**1.9. Payment of fee**

On receipt of allotment order, the candidate has to pay the prescribed fee immediately in the form of Demand Draft in US dollars drawn in favour of **“The Finance Officer, TANUVAS, Chennai”** payable at **Chennai.**

**Note: For each extended year of study, an additional fee of US \$ 3,000 p.a. will be charged.**

### 1.9.2. Development fee

An one time development fee of US \$ 2000 shall be paid at the time of admission for each degree programme.

### 1.9.3. Other fees

Tuition fees, special fees, examination fees, boarding and lodging fees etc., should be paid either in Indian rupee or its equivalent in US Dollars at the time of admission or when required to be paid as per the rules of the University.

**Fees including institutional economic fee and development fee once paid are not refundable**

### 1.10. Fitness

Candidates have to submit a medical fitness certificate at the time of final allotment as per Annexure-II.

## 2. GENERAL INFORMATION

### 2.1. Reporting to the University

The academic session shall usually begin tentatively by **first week of September** every year. Candidates selected for admission are required to report to the Dean of the college concerned on the scheduled date mentioned in the allotment order. If the candidate fails to do so, the offer of admission will automatically stands cancelled.

### 2.2. Hostel Accommodation

Limited Hostel accommodation is available inside the campus. Interested candidates may apply to the Dean of the campus for Hostel accommodation. They have to pay the prescribed fee as per Hostel Rules. There is no separate Hostel for Foreign Nationals students. The Hostel Mess is run on dividing system.

**2.3.** All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They shall be liable to cancellation at any stage during the study if it is found that an admission was contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicants or their parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.

- 2.4. Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University reserves the right to cancel or vary any of these rules without any prior notice.

**3. PREVENTION OF RAGGING**
