I. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO BVSc & AH, BTech (Food Technology), BTech (Poultry Technology) and BTech (Dairy Technology) DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions given below as on the last date of submission of online application are eligible to apply. Passing the qualifying examination after the last date of submission of online application will not be considered.

A. Nativity:

- ❖ Candidates should be a **Native of Tamil Nadu State.**
- ❖ Candidates who have passed VIII, IX, X, XI and XII Std. in Tamil Nadu are eligible to apply. **They need not enclose Nativity Certificate.**
- ❖ Tamil Nadu native candidates who have passed any of the VIII, IX, X, XI and XII Std. or their equivalent examination from schools situated outside Tamil Nadu **should enclose Nativity Certificate as given in Prospectus.**

B. Qualifying Examinations and Minimum Marks:

- ❖ A pass in the Higher Secondary Course (10+2) / CBSE / any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto and fulfilling the following requirements are mandatory.

C. Number of Attempts:

The maximum number of attempts made for passing the qualifying examination is limited to **three for SC / SCA / ST candidates and two for other candidates.**

THE IMPROVEMENT MARKS IN HSC OR EQUIVALENT EXAMINATION OF ANY YEAR WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

D. Age Limit:

- Candidates should have attained the age of **17 years as on 31st December, 2017.**
- Candidates applying for the under graduate degree programmes should not have completed the age mentioned below as on **01.07.2017:**

- **No relaxation of minimum and maximum age limit is permissible on any grounds.**

II. MODE OF SELECTION

- Candidates will be selected strictly based on their performance in the qualifying examination and Community reservation policy of the Government of Tamil Nadu.

III. ONLINE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

⇒ Candidates may submit online applications at www.tanuvas.ac.in, www2.tanuvas.ac.in from 15.05.2017, 10:00 AM to 31.05.2017, 6:00 PM.

ONLY ONLINE APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED.

OTHER FORMATS OF APPLICATION WILL SUMMARILY BE REJECTED.

⇒ If the candidate is not able to fill in all the required columns, he / she may save the application for future use. Upon saving the application, the candidate will be receiving **LOGIN ID and PASSWORD** through SMS to the registered mobile number, which can be used for subsequent access.

⇒ Candidates may apply for **ONE OR MORE DEGREE PROGRAMMES THROUGH A SINGLE ONLINE APPLICATION BY CHOOSING APPROPRIATE PROGRAMMES WITH REQUISITE PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEES** as detailed below.

⇒ After the **online submission of application**, the candidate will receive an SMS and e-mail that **his / her application(s) is (are) submitted successfully.**

⇒ After submitting the online application and online payment, the candidates should take the printout of the filled online application form, attach the relevant certificates / documents duly attested for each degree programmes separately.

⇒ If the candidate has applied for more than one degree course, the downloaded online filled application along with necessary enclosures should be placed in a **separate unfolded envelope superscribed with name of the degree programme and placed in a bigger unfolded cover** and send to
