Continuing Veterinary Education Programme to Veterinary Practitioners

Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS), the first of its kind in India, was established in the year 1989. The Directorate has seven Teaching and one Peripheral Veterinary Hospital under its ambit. Approximately 10 participants will be engaged in each training programme with a course fee of Rs. 8000/- + 18% GST (Rs. 9440/-) (Excluding Boarding and lodging) for each participants.
