TANUVAS COLLABORATES WITH R&D INSTITUTIONS

AMemorandum of Understanding (MoU) was executed between Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University and Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research (SRIHER), Porur, Chennai on 15.05.2019 to collaborate in teaching and research programmes in the core competent areas with



special focus on health care education for a period of five years. This partnership will also facilitate in developing dialysis membrane from animal sources, evaluation of biomarkers, therapeutic biomolecules, nutraceuticals, novel eco-friendly nanotechnology based drugs and targeted drug delivery system. The MoU was signed by Dr. P. Tensingh Gnanaraj, Registrar, TANUVAS and Thiru V. Swaminathan, Registrar, SRIHER, Chennai in the presence of Dr.C.Balachandran, Vice-Chancellor, TANUVAS. Dr. T.J. Harikrishnan, Director of Research, TANUVAS, Chennai was also present.

Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University and K.J. Research Foundation (KJRF), Chennai executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 25.04.2019 to carry out collaborative programmes in research and development in the area of autoimmune disorders, stem cell research, herbal treatment for diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis, osteoporosis and porcine model experiments, facilitates collaborative doctoral and post-doctoral research in biotechnology and envisages exchange programmes between TANUVAS and KJRF faculty. Under this MoU, KJRF will provide fellowship of Rs.5,000/- every year to one student in M. Phil (Biotechnology) for pursuing research. This MoU was signed by Dr. P.
