HON'BLE MINISTER FOR ANIMAL HUSBANDRY VISIT TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND



A delegation led by Thiru. Udumalai K. Radhakrishnan, Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry, Government of Tamil Nadu comprising Dr. C. Balachandran, Vice-Chancellor, TANUVAS and Thiru. A. Gnanasekaran, I.A.S., Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Govt. of Tamil Nadu visited selected educational institutions in Australia and New Zealand from 06.09.2019 to 15.09.2019 with the specific objectives to demonstrate the academic, research and extension capabilities of TANUVAS to foster faculty, scientist and student exchange and research collaborations with Australian and New Zealand Institutes, to identify mutual research interests in the selected fields of veterinary science to identify novel strategies to improve animal health in the face of climate change and for potential adoption of cross-cultural farm management practices for sustainable farming in Australia, New Zealand and India.

The delegates visited University of Sydney, Camden on 09.09.2019 and held meeting with Professor David Emery, Associate Professor Navneet Dhand, Associate Professor John House, Assistant Professor Auriol Purdie and Senior Research Fellow Mehen Khatken. The delegation also visited the various facilities in the University of Sydney. Agreement on signing of MoU for students / professors / scientist exchange programme, supporting Advanced Institute for Integrated Research on Livestock and Animal Sciences at Salem as required and jointly proposing collaborative research projects.

The delegation visited La Trobe University, Melbourne (Bundoora) on 10.09.2019 and met Prof. Terry Spithill and Associate Professor Dr. Travis Beddoe



at Centre for AgriBioscience (AgriBio). The visit outcome yielded involving in joint work on disease diagnosis, vaccine development, joint research collaboration and acceptance to sign MoU for students / faculty / scientist exchange programme.

Dr. Vignesh Rathinasamy and Dr. Sushma Anand of Monash University, Clayton warmly received Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry, Government of Tamil Nadu led delegation on 10.09.2019 and briefed about the current research activities of Monash University.

Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry, Government of Tamil Nadu and his team visited Federation University of Australia, Churchill on



11.09.2019 and held discussions with Associate Professor David Piedrafita (Associate Dean for Research), Prof. Talal Yusuf (Pro-Vice-Chancellor, International Operations) and Associate Professor Wendy Wright on the potential for student and staff exchange between the Universities for exposure to international research and education. The meeting resulted in the decision to sign MoU to jointly work

on disease diagnosis, vaccine development, research activities and student/staff exchange.

The delegation visited Australian Animal Health Laboratory (AAHL), Geelong, Australia - A CSIRO Laboratory on 12.09.2019 and met the various groups of scientists working on different animal diseases under the leadership of Dr. Debbes Eagles, Deputy Director of AAHL. A total of 20 scientists participated in the interactions held with the objective to explore areas of future collaborative research platforms and training for BSL3 laboratory management. During the discussion, Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry, Government of Tamil Nadu explained the scientists about the support provided by the Government of



Tamil Nadu towards development of Animal Husbandry sector and informed about the Advanced Institute for Integrated Research on Livestock and Animal Sciences to be established at Salem district, Tamil Nadu. Providing technical assistance to establish / upgrade the existing laboratories, transfer advanced technologies to Tamil Nadu, involving in joint research collaboration and acceptance to sign MoU for exchange programme were the outcome of the visit of the delegation to AAHL.

On 13.09.2019, the delegation visited the Livestock Improvement Corporation (LIC), Hamilton, New Zealand and learned about its Innovation Farm and state-of-the art laboratories and processing facilities.



They also had discussions with Dr. Ala Mohan, Animal Health Manager, LIC and her team during the visit.
