and work experience as notified by the Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O. (Ms) No. 214, Animal Husbandry, Dairving, and Fisheries (AH-6), dated 6th November 2017, and Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Notification No. 358, dated 6th November 2017, a copy of which is available on the Tamil Nadu

The Vice-Chancellor shall hold the office for a period of three years (provided that the person appointed as Vice-Chancellor shall retire from office if, during the term of office, he/she attains the age of 70 years).
